



UPS has long practiced line-item services and invoicing. With increasing rates, we now list line items on our invoice. USPS (US Postal Service) offers some better services with flat-rate boxes. Be sure you and your post office communicate with delivery of larger parcels. USPS also tends to offer an advantage with small shipments to Alaska and Hawaii.

All parcel post shipment shipments

Shipping charge - This is the basic shipping service based on space, weight and distance.

Fuel surcharge (UPS) - Based on the price of fuel - a percentage of the shipping charges.

Packaging material fee - Covers boxes, tape, etc

Fees for Canadian shipments - Export costs billed to us are passed on to you. Brokerage fees, tariffs, sales taxes, etc are paid on your end.

Optional charges - normally does not apply to dealers

Residential delivery fee (UPS) - Applies to YOU - any home or farm.

“Irregular packaging” (UPS) - They favor 6-sided boxes and charge for irregular packaging of bulky parts. It may be better to ship by motor truck.

Larger shipment of smaller parts

We reserve the right to ship some parts orders by motor truck to avoid excessive UPS packaging. In general, shipments over 200 lbs are typically better shipped by motor truck. See previous page for details on motor truck shipping.
