**30311 Leveling Bar Asby** for 3101 - 3201

**40311 Leveling Bar Asby** for 5101 - 5201

A Leveling Bar leaves a more-level finish, helps crumble soil on the bed top and/or knocks bed down to a consistent bed height. Example on Page 1-1.



**30329 Leveling Pan Asby** for 3101

40329 Leveling Pan Asby for 5101

A Leveling Pan can leave a smoother bed top. The flat pan surface also provides depth control of disk gangs, which is adjustable.

## 40455 Ripper Shank Asby 18589 Ripper Point for 5201

Ripper shanks fracture soil ahead of disk blades as wanted for penetration. Also install middle shank to fracture root zone. Maximum three shanks on this hitch and toolbar. Two or three middle shanks are possible - please inquire. This 1-1/4 x 4 shank has 25 HP rating.
